A Mission Trip to Congo-DRC

In light of the goals and objectives of the “*Building Bridges of Solidarity with Africa*” conference that took place at Concordia University Chicago from June 29 through July 1, 2007, Pastor Stéphane Kalonji and Dr. Susan Busse will lead a short-term mission trip to Africa in June 23 – July 14, 2008, giving an opportunity to those involved to give witness about their faith in Jesus Christ by 1) **training local leaders on how to do outreach through small group ministry**, providing 2) **free medical treatment to patients** and 3) **feeding children suffering from malnutrition**. In many villages and cities of Congo-DRC, people gather in small groups in the evenings to hear tribal stories told by the community’s elders. Why not use these small groups as a springboard for sharing the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ!
